Call to Worship:

We thank you God of wisdom for all the gifts that our women are gifted with.

Leader: Let us be grateful to God for our families, churches, and our institutions!

All: We are grateful to you Oh God for our foremothers, our families, churches and our institutions! We are grateful for their sacrifices and the challenges overcome by them, which stand out as examples for our families, churches and our institutions. We thank you for all blessings we receive from you through them!

Prayer of Confession

Leader: Let us repent and confess before God, As we celebrate the International Women's Day, as we express our Gratitude to God and to our women, let us also confess that very often we have made women and girl children suffocate and breathless in our country, in our churches and in our families. Let us all repent before God and before the gathering!

All: Dear God our Mother & Father, who is full of love and compassion, you formed us from the dust of the earth and breathed your image in us and you placed us in the garden of this world to live in harmony and bring peace into the world. But we failed and often we become the cause of conflicts and quarrels. Our God of compassion, we confess that we really did not celebrate the life of women number of times. We, very often have caused damage to the lives of our women and girl children. Very often we are silent when our women face violence. Very often we succumb to the abusive culture of the society which is contradictory to the teaching of Jesus for Justice and wholeness for all. We confess our sins before you Oh Lord our God of Compassion. Forgive us Lord!

Men: Mother God, we confess that we too often create labels for women such as inferior, weak and impure instead of seeing your powerful and lovable image in them as they are created in your image.

Women: Sustaining Life Energy, we confess that we believed the labels such as inferior, weak and impure were ordained and given by God, which is not true. Forgive us for believing and accepting stories of untruth.

Men: God the Creator who created women and men equally! We confess that we have created a world that denies women's rights and degrades their being. Forgive us Lord.

Women: God the Creator who created us in your image, We confess we have failed to speak up for our rights and the rights of our sisters. Forgive us for not being instrumental in transforming the world into a place of equality, justice and peace. Forgive us for our silence.

Men: Our God above everyone! We confess today on this special day as we are celebrating the International Women's Day that we have assumed that we are the standard and we have

ignored the power that women have been bestowed upon . Forgive us for we are blind in our thinking, assumptions and action.

Women: Our dear God the source of life, We confess that we often assumed that we are only emotional beings and are powerless . We have accepted silently all that has been imposed on us without questioning the oppressive systems within our families, churches and society. Forgive us for being part of the oppressive systems that subjugate women and marginalize them.

All: Keeper and Companion of us all, forgive us for not being co-creators of a new world of equality; we have forgotten to travel with our sisters to help them dance like Miriam for the freedom; we apologize for compromising our positions in not accepting women as Deborahs to judge our world, to make decisions and offer counsel. Forgive us for not appreciating the partnership in recognizing our gifts and responsibilities in creating a new community and a new world.

Absolution

Leader: Let us remember that we are spiritual beings having human experience! Therefore as spiritual beings, let us be reconciled to God and to people around us and experience the assurance of forgiveness. The power of the Spirit of God, would cleans us and empower us to be the partners and co-creators with God! May God inspire us to be like Christ to give life in abundance to the people around us! Amen

Intercessory Prayers: Franciscan Prayer for International Women's Day (Adapted)
